Ours is a very small College with only two departments which offer very specialized courses, namely Hospitality (including Bakery) and Media. Students who join our College come having already decided the profession they wish to pursue. Hence, none of them wish to appear for Civil Service Examinations, nor do they desire to go into IITs, IIMs other Management Institutions.

The greater numbers of students who complete the BSc in Hospitality Studies Programme wish to join a hotel or some allied industry (e.g. airlines as stewards, or cruise liners); a few join family hospitality or catering businesses or start their own small enterprises. Very few of them wish to pursue further studies. Those who wish to go in for further studies abroad join hotel management or culinary institutes who admit them based on their results, transcripts, letters of recommendations from faculty online/offline which the faculty give very willingly. Except for clearing the English language examination, namely IELTS, they do not require to appear for any other, e.g. GRE/GMAT etc.

The SCM programme is a post-graduate one. The majority of the students who join this programme wish to pursue a career in media. The few who want to pursue further studies generally do so only after having gained work experience in the field of their choice at least for a couple of years. These are selected by the Colleges / Universities they apply to for further studies on the basis of their portfolios, transcripts and recommendations from faculty.

Therefore, please note that the only examination relevant to our College, and that too only for a small percentage of students of the Hospitality Studies programme, is IELTS.
