Dear Sr Anila,

As you know, I am working on a research study about modernity as shown in Tamil television programmes. The title of the paper is 'Should you listen to your wife? Tamil language television debates on modernity' and it examines a television show on social issues called Sirappu Pattimanram (literary debate) that airs on SunTV. I presented a paper based on this study via videoconference at a panel titled 'Beyond the Desirable: Critical Perspectives on Media-Modernity' at The Swedish South Asian Studies Network (SASNET) conference on "Modern Matters: Negotiating the Future in Everyday Life in South Asia" held at Lund University from 20-22 September 2016 in Lund, Sweden.

Along with globalization, modernities have become a key area for research in the media since different cultures have adopted media in different ways to tell stories about what is valued in their cultures.

My paper received a positive response and has now been accepted for publication in the international journal Culture Unbound, for a thematic issue preliminarily titled 'Critical Explorations of Media Modernities in South Asia' which is scheduled to be published in June 2018. As we all know, a publication in an international journal will add to the SCM department and the college's research output in a serious way and will also be valued by external ranking agencies such as Outlook magazine.

The panel chairs Prof Per Stahlberg, Prof Britta Ohm and Prof Vibodh Parthasarathi have advised me to interview the participants of the Tamil television debate show to supplement the content analysis that I had presented at the conference and strengthen the arguments in the paper. I am planning to travel to Chennai and Madurai to interview the channel representatives at SunTV, programme participants and viewers.

As discussed in the IQAC meeting, I am hereby applying for the faculty research grant to support my travel and incidental expenses for this research paper.
